Application information

Calendar

Ability to add events to a calendar, such as events, location information, times, costs etc...

Blog

Online journal, can be used for a wide variety of activities such as logging events and sharing personal insights.

Integrated forum

An integrated discussion board where topics can be diversified into sub-categories and discussion threads creating a place where users can talk.

Integrated user system

A system where a web site user can login and gain access to certain content that other users may not.

Includes: Login, logout, message other users, assign user groups and member profiles.

Fully featured contact form

A page on your web site that a user can access and use to send you an email to enquire about your company/product.

Gallery

Ability to upload and electronically publish images to your web site.

Mailing list

The ability to mass email a group of users that subscribe to your list.

Interactive chat (live support)

Ability for a member of your staff to sign in and answer queries/questions live over the internet.

Ecommerce system

An online catalogue of products for sale via the web, payments can be taken easily through PayPal or other payment methods such as Google Checkout.
